Importance in Stopping Deleting Cyberbullying

Today's youth are faced with all types of terrible and appalling situations, however, one of the newest and most troubling situations is Cyber-bullying. The estimated number of youth who have experienced Cyber-bullying are increasing and at a global proportion. While Cyber-bullying is happening mostly to teenagers and young adults aged 14-26, it could happen to anyone of any age.

While technology is becoming more sophisticated, allowing us immediate access to information, which could greatly benefit our lives, it could also potentially provide individuals with the means to exploit personal information, commit cyber-crimes, or even inflict injury to others. One type of cyber-crime in particular is Cyber-bullying. Fact is, that an overwhelming majority of teenagers believe that this type of bullying is a joke, not realizing the devastating impact it could have on the victim.

Cyber-bullying needs to be eliminated, because the effects of this kind of bullying can be detrimental to the victim, causing anything from depression to suicide. So, just what is Cyber-bullying? It is an act of persecution and mistreatment or cruelty that takes place within a digital setting, most commonly over the Internet or on any Online-based forums. It can include negative, derogatory, or abusive comments; as well as threats to exploit private details about the victim.

In this day and age teenagers use technology more than ever; most have access to access to high-speed Internet, which they use to send pictures and messages to their friends, create personal blogs or online videos, and create personal profiles on social networks. Cyber-bullying can take place on social

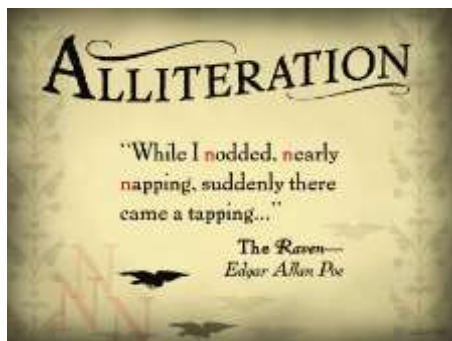
networks such as Facebook, My Space or Twitter, etc. but it can also take place in online chat rooms, through emails, text or picture messages or any other place where technology is used.

According to studies by the Cyber-Bullying Resource Center, "Prior to the summer of 2011, such reports that included Cyber-bullying victimization rates, ranged from 5.5% to 70% with the average being 24.4%. Their studies also shown the percent of youth who responded to their surveys have experienced Cyber-bullying at some point in their lifetime, at rates ranging from 18.8% to 40.6% with the average being 27.3%." The deviations are limitless! However, much of the variations in these studies can be explained by the approach used. Cyber-bullying usually takes place as a result of prejudice or prejudgments towards the individual's sexual orientation, age, race, cultural or religious background, appearance, physical or mental disability, or socioeconomic position.

Despite joint efforts to teach teenagers about cyber-safety, they can still become victims of Cyber-bullying. So, what can be done to eliminate Cyber-bullying? First, we must understand what the definition of Cyber-bullying is and how to recognize it. Then, after you have explained to your teens about the dangers of the Internet, you should also let them know that they will not be punished for being a victim of Cyber-bullying. Always deal with Cyber-bullying as soon as it happens, never ignore it. Report it to the appropriate agency; for instance, if the incident happens at school, report it to the principal or administrator of the school; if the incident happens while you're teen is at home on the Internet, report to the administrator of your Internet service. If the Cyber-bullying includes threats of physical violence, or is done by an anonymous individual, report it to the local police. The police can track down who is committing the act.

If you or someone you know has been or is currently the victim of Cyber-bullying, you should contact the National Cyber Alert System, which is sponsored by the United States Department of Homeland Security, they can be contacted at (888) 282-0870. Individuals are also encouraged to contact the National Crime Prevention Council at (202) 466-6272. Remember that Cyber-bullying is a crime. No one deserves to undergo any kind of abuse and needs to be eliminated. If we join forces, we can prevent Cyber-bullying and eliminate it once and for all.

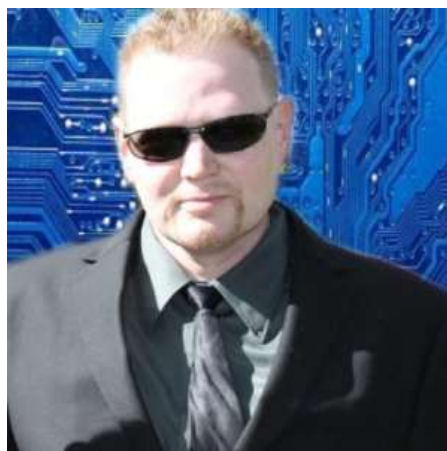

Why the stock market is important to all of us?



Do you own stocks? If not, you may not think that the rise or fall of the stock market is important to you; however, the value of various stocks and mutual funds affects a lot more of us than most people are aware of. Do you have a bank account? Do you have a pension or retirement fund? If so, then the world of stock trading does affect you, at least indirectly.

When you deposit money into your bank account, the bank doesn't take those funds, convert them into cash, and then stuff that cash under a mattress with your account number stenciled on the side. The bank takes those funds and invests them in various short and long term assets, and then earns profits from those investments. The bank must guarantee that they can pay out to you, upon request, any amount that you have deposited (minus fees, taxes, penalties, etc.) and is federally insured to cover those amounts (up to a certain maximum per deposit). This means that since most people deposit an amount, then withdraw and pay out smaller amounts over time, the bank has at its disposal a large sum of money to use for investing. They invest in stocks, bonds, mutual funds, foreign currency, precious metals, futures, and many other assets that they can keep or sell to make a profit.

If we look at the profit and loss statements of our bank, we see that they make very little money from the bank fees that we pay. Their profits are generated by the investments that they make with the available funds that we entrust them with. If the stock markets are up, our banks are generally earning more profits. If the markets are down, our banks' profits are reduced. When our banks are not making as much money from their investments that is when we see a rise in banking fees, and reductions in staff. Have you ever been stuck in line at your bank branch waiting for one of two available tellers? Did you notice that these understaffing incidents tend to coincide with reduced stock market activity?

Even small, privately owned businesses are affected by fluctuations in the stock market. If a hair salon buys its products from a large, publicly traded company, those product prices will often rise or fall according to the profit needs of the manufacturer. As the value of a large company's stock declines, the company must, at some point, make up those profits elsewhere, usually by raising their prices. As the price of supplies increases, so does the price of services that use those supplies, and so on.

Even if you don't directly invest in stocks, the activity of the stock markets still affects all of us, at least indirectly. If our bank loses too much money in bad investments, it may not be able to meet its obligations to its account holders, and have to close. When that happens, even if we recover all of the funds we had deposited there, we will still need to find a new bank. The costs of running a business, large or small, are dependent upon the financial security of its bank, its suppliers, and ultimately its customers, all of whom are affected by the economy, which is expressed in the activities of stock values and trading.

Strength to carry on



When I look back over my life, it has been filled with many road blocks, bad choices, deaths and adversities--yet, somehow, somehow I have always found the strength to carry on.

I sometimes wonder whether it was my friends, my family, my children, my mate or God himself that gave me the strength to keep a positive attitude in the mist of the storm--All I know is that I have always found the strength to carry on.

When I was seven years old I saw my

stepfather murdered during a home invasion--yet I found the strength to carry on.

At the age of nine I was forced to perform oral sex on my 26-year-old babysitter and was threatened if I told my mother or anyone he would kill both me and my mother, so I kept this deep dark secret until I was grown--but I found the strength to carry on.

My family was evicted from the projects, we lived in a homeless shelter for three months, and while we were moving some of our things to the homeless shelter I was in an accident which left me with a broken neck. It happened on a Friday afternoon, I didn't even know I was injured. But, when I woke up Monday morning and I was paralyzed from my neck to my waist, we walked 20+ miles to the hospital, I could have been paralyzed for life or even died during the surgery, but yet I found the strength to carry on.

At 14, I became pregnant, had my neck broken a second time when I was walking away from a fight, I lost my child's father in a car accident by a drunk driver when he was on his way home from a job in Kentucky, my family became homeless because my mother had to quit her job to take care of me, I was still homeless when I went into labor. Yet, the worst thing of all was that my daughter contracted HIV from a blood transfusion when she was a few weeks old --yet I found the strength to carry on.

I was married at the age of 20, six months later I found out my husband was having an affair with a 14-year-old and she was carrying his child, I developed double pneumonia and was hospitalized for three months, during my stay my right lung collapsed, and I developed a pea-sized blood-clot in the main valve of my heart due to an infected PICC line (a kind of long-term IV), I lost temporary custody of my daughter, and my foster son was placed back in the foster care system, I had a nervous breakdown, then when I was finally released from the hospital I found out I did not have a home to go to, so I was homeless again--But again, somehow, someway I found the strength to carry on.

When I was 25 I made the worst decision of my life I started smoking crack cocaine after being influenced by my second husband, I became instantly addicted- but I still found the strength to carry on.

At 26, I lost custody of my daughter again this time she never came home, my adopted son was placed in foster care never to return, all after I had gone through a drug rehabilitation program to get clean from

drugs. Then on New Year's Eve my mother was found dead in her apartment, she had died three days earlier from liver failure due to hepatitis C, three weeks later my daughter died from AIDS-related complications while in foster care, the day before Easter-I committed suicide by taking a bottle of muscle relaxers-I was pronounced dead for two minutes and spent 48 hours in the Intensive Care Unit, my second husband left me for another woman then I tried to commit suicide again by smoking myself to death, when I rushed to the hospital I was told I had lethal levels of crack cocaine in my system, I spent 72 hours in the ICU, only to come home with nowhere to go again, I had become homeless once again this time I had no family, no children, no husband and no will to live--but by God's grace I found the strength to carry on.

From the age of 27 to 31 I was completely addicted to crack cocaine, I did things, unspeakable things that I would have never done in my right mind, I was arrested several times for shop-lifting, I turned tricks until one of my tricks strangled me until I blacked out and he raped me and left me for dead, I became homeless yet again, and when I was admitted to the rehabilitation program I weighed only 88 pounds, but through some force greater than my own I found the strength to carry on.

At the age of 36, I found out I had severe cervical dysplasia and needed to have surgery. I was told that if I had any drugs in my system that the doctor could not perform the surgery. So I stopped smoking crack cocaine on January 14, 2009 and haven't looked back. By the time I was 39-years-old, I was having my fifth surgery in four years on December 19, 2012, but I know God has brought me through too many trials and tribulations to die now-so I know he will provide me the strength to carry on.

Over the last few years I have been homeless, but found a new lease on life, I was reunited with my son, now have my first grandson, found a good man, moved into my own place, launched an Internet-based writing company, have gone back to school to receive a bachelor's degree in English—currently holding a 3.78GPA and through it all I will find the strength to carry on.

So, whenever you are faced with hard times or adversities, just think of me and do what I do, which is praise God to give you the strength to carry on.

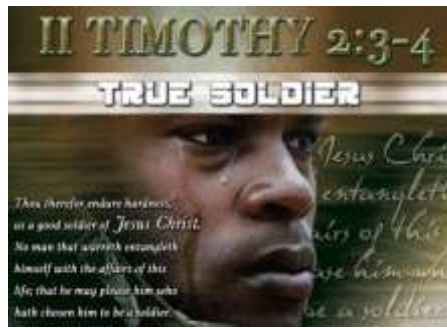
